

St Marys C of E School Uniform Policy

At St Marys we pride ourselves on our professional presentation. School uniform plays a valuable part in contributing to the ethos of the school and setting appropriate tone. Our Uniform Policy is to be adhered to by all pupils.

General: **White** shirt/blouse
Grey trousers/skirt/pinafore dress/shorts
Navy jumper/cardigan
Blue and white checked dress
Plain **white, grey** or **black** socks/plain tights
Black plain flat shoes/ankle boots
School tie
Hair clips, slides, headbands must be discrete and in school colours

P.E: **White** polo shirt/plain white T-shirt
Navy shorts
Navy jogging bottoms
Navy sweatshirt
Black pumps/trainers
Hair must be tied back and jewellery removed

NOTE:

Your child must be able to remove jewellery themselves or must be removed at home on the day of PE in line with Health & Safety guidance. Staff will not be responsible for removing earrings.

All clothing and footwear should be clearly labelled with your child's name.

The following items are **NOT** considered appropriate school wear:

- High heels, platform soled shoes
- Trainers
- Hooded garments
- Hoop or pendant earrings
- Nail varnish
- Make up
- Tattoo transfers
- Hair colour/glitter
- Jewellery and fashion accessories

Reception class children are given a school book bag when they start. Uniform for all pupils including ties or book bags with the school logo on can be ordered at the School Office via Vortex.
