

-I can hold the book the right way up and turn the pages carefully.


Ideas to help your child at home...

- ◆ Share books, magazines with your child as much as possible. Show them the correct way to hold them and allowing them to turn the pages.
- ◆ Read stories more than once to them encouraging them to say what is going to happen.
- ◆ Share stories asking them at points to say what may be on the next page.
- ◆ Use words like 'at the beginning/end of the story' so your child comes familiar with the different parts.
- ◆ Create a box of favourite stories so they can have access to them all the time.
- ◆ Make up own stories
- ◆ Use props/puppets to retell or make own stories.

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
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
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
