I would like to take this opportunity to tell you our plans for the next academic year with regards to classes and staffing.

Reception - Miss Gulliver will teach the reception class. She will be supported by Mrs Ellam and Miss Murray.

Year 1 – Will be taught by Miss Bell. She will be supported by Mrs Mellor.

Year 2 – Miss Wood will continue to teach Year 2 as last year she successfully passed her NQT year in school. Year 2 will be supported by Miss Castor-Smith for four days and Miss Cook for the other day.

Year 3 – Will be taught by Miss Pollard Monday to Wednesday, with Mrs Brook teaching from Wednesday to Friday. They will be supported by Mrs Tryba. Mrs Brook will continue her role as SEN co-ordinator.

Year 4 – Will be taught by Mrs Thomas from Monday to Wednesday and by Mrs Copley on Thursdays and Fridays. They will be supported by Mrs Kitchen.

Year 5 – Miss Ryan will continue teaching in Year 5. Mrs Parker will support the class for some of the mornings and Miss Abson and Miss Walters will support in the class as well.

time to carry out the day-to-day running of the school in my absence and lead on supporting teaching and learning, literacy and behaviour.


We look forward to continuing to work with you in the next academic year.
