Dear Parents/Carers

As we come to the end of another very odd school year, can I say a huge thank you to you all for your support and understanding during this difficult time. Sadly, it has been a year of restrictions, lack of classes mixing, bubble closures, individual and family isolations and changes to almost every aspect of school life. However, throughout this all, the pupils have been amazing. They have taken on board all the changes, e.g. hand sanitising, sitting in rows, not being able to play with children from other classes and temporary school closures, exceptionally well. They have shown their resilience, determination and energy to succeed. They have adapted brilliantly to new ways of working and as a school, we could not be prouder of every single one of them.

From September, we will of course be following the operational guidance as laid out by Government. This will be used to develop our risk assessments and plans for September. I am sorry I am not able to be in school at the moment to say goodbye in person, but I do wish them (and you) all the very best for the future.
