This week we were delighted to invite parents into school to hear about our reading curriculum at St Mary's. We are so proud of the curriculum we have in place for reading and are proud to share this with other schools across Barnsley too. Thank you to the parents that attended, and we hope you found this useful. Also, a huge thank you to Ms Steele for her leadership of this area- we have an immersive culture of reading that we are truly proud of. Today, we have seen Year Five and Year Six attend the Remembrance Service at the Town Hall; exemplary behaviour from all pupils meant we received many compliments too. This afternoon, we also have some pupils in Year 3 and 4 taking part in a cross-country event- thank you to Ms Saynor for your organisation of this. I cannot wait to hear how the event has gone when they return to school. On Thursday, we were also delighted to welcome Mr Ormondroyd into school to start practising songs for Christmas production. Mr Ormondroyd is the music lead at West Meadows- one of our Trust schools. He will be working with years 5, 4 and 3 weekly as they start rehearsals for the Christmas production.

Anti-Bullying Week

It is Anti-Bullying Week next week (14^{th} November – 18^{th} November). The theme this year is 'Reach Out'. We will be having odd socks day on Monday children can take part if they wish. It is uniform as usual with odd socks. Pupils will take part in different activities through the week.

We also have something brand new this year. We are taking part in the Nationwide/Diana Award campaign 'Positive Post-box'. We have now received a Positive Post Box in school.

These letters are then going to be collected and shared with a partner school in the UK. We hopefully will receive letters back from another school.
