#### **Medical Information**

All medicines must be handed in at the office so a medicine form can be completed, and staff made aware of any child needing medicines in their class. It is important that these are not left with the children, either in water bottles or in their bags, as other children in the class may accidently have access to these. If your child is suffering from diarrhoea and/or sickness, please remember it is 48 hours from their last bout before they should come back into school. This minimises the risk of spreading this contagious illness to other children.

# **Absences**

Please ensure you call school on each day of your child's absence, unless advised otherwise, either by speaking to a member of staff or leaving a message on the absence line. Failure to inform school of your child's absence will result in an unauthorised absence mark on the register. Ten or more of these marks can result in a council fine. Evidence is needed for any medical appointments taken during the school day.
