

Strike Action

Just to make you aware, following a ballot of its members, the National Union of Education Union (NEU) has announced two more strike dates:

- Thursday 27th April 2023
- Tuesday 2nd May 2023

Based on the information we currently hold; it is our intention to remain open on these dates for all

pupils as we have on previous strike days. However, if on any of the dates listed above, staff shortages fall below minimum requirements, it may mean that we are unable to deliver normal provision. In these circumstances, we would consider the following:

- restricting attendance to vulnerable children
- closing specific year groups/classes
- closing the school

We will only consider restricting attendance or closing the school if we were unable to provide safe staffing levels.

Just to remind you that that on the 26th May we will be hosting our first dress as a word day in school. Children can come to school dressed as a word. Throughout the day, children will take part in lots of tasks linked to vocabulary and oracy.
