Dear Parents/Carers,

First of all, I would like to thank the Year 6 children on working so hard this week in SATs week. They have worked incredibly hard and tried their very best- we really are very proud. Children in Year 6 will receive their Sats results by the 7<sup>th</sup> July. Next week, our Year 2 children will sit their SATs tests in school. The children have only been told that they are doing some special quizzes in school and Miss Bell shares the children are excited to work on their booklets. Assessments in Year 2 form part of Miss Bell's teacher assessment judgment and will be shared with parents in the children's reports at the end of the year.

Pupils in Reception class and Year One also took part in a live question and answer session with two physiotherapists this week which was a great experience.
