<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In French, there are different sounds to the sounds we have learned in phonics and spellings. For example, the sound 'oi' in French is pronounced /wa/.</li> <li>Some French words look the same as English, but they may sound different e.g. six is spelled the same but sounds different in each language.</li> </ul>		Classroom commands				ez - regardez é – répétez i - mardi un - lundi	ch - dimanche en - vendredi er - janvier an - janvier

<b>What should I know by the end?</b>		Days				<b>What should I be able to do by the end?</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In French, commands end in 'ez', for example 'écoutez' means listen.</li> <li>Most days of the week end in 'i' (except Sunday).</li> <li>We don't need to use capital letters for days of the week or months of the year like we do in English.</li> <li>When writing the date in French, we put the day, then the number, then the month (e.g. lundi 3 mars).</li> <li>We don't need to put 'th' or any other little digits after the number, UNLESS it is the first of the month. Then we put 'er' (e.g. mardi 1er mai).</li> </ul>		lundi	<i>Monday</i>	vendredi	<i>Friday</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Listen and respond to classroom commands.</li> <li>Recognise days of the week and months of the year.</li> <li>Say what day it is and what month it is</li> <li>Write the date.</li> </ul>
