<u>Conjugating verbs</u>																			
- In French, the spelling of a verb changes depending on who is doing the verb. - Lots of root verbs in French end in 'er', and all 'er' verbs follow the same rules when changing the spellings. In this topic we will use the verb 'porter' – to wear. - When we are using 'porter' with a pronoun, we take off the 'er' and put the correct ending on (look at the vocabulary list). - Most of the time we will use 1st, 2nd and 3rd person, so we need to know the endings that go with I, You, He and She. - It is good to get used to seeing the other ones too! 		<u>Adjectives</u> - Most adjectives come after the noun. - Size adjectives come before the noun. - If the noun is feminine, we usually add an 'e' to the adjective unless it already ends in an 'e'. - There are some exceptions to the rule above: e.g. un long pull - a long jumper une longue robe – a long skirt		Describing what someone is wearing		How will I use this learning in the future?
