-In History, we look at things that have happened in the past.

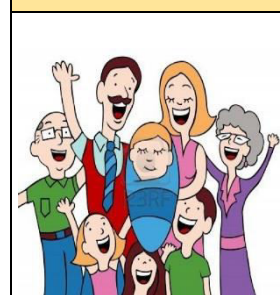
We look at the things humans have done in the past, to try and help us understand the present, and what may happen in the future.

Understanding the World – People, Culture and Communities

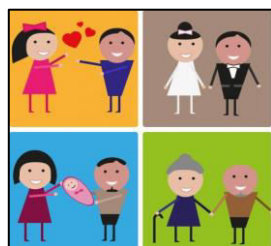


Family and Friends

- Family are people who are related to one another.
- Friends are people who like spending time together.
- What do families do to celebrate. How have we celebrated our birthday / special occasions in the past

Experiences

- An experience is something that happens to us in our lives. Children to draw on the experiences they have had in the past.

Life events may include:

- Birthday -Starting school -Birth of brother/sister
- Wedding -Christening -Achievements/ success!



Ways of Life & Occupations

- We share some things with other people. Some things make us unique (different to everyone else).
- A way of life is how you choose to spend your time.
- An occupation is a job – what you do for work.
- Occupations include: teacher, policeman, chef, etc.

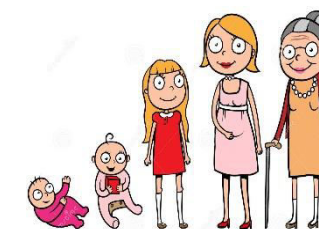
Understanding the World – Past and Present

Past and Present

Children at the expected level of development will: - Talk about the lives of the people around them and their roles in society; - Know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now, drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class; - Understand the past through settings, characters and events encountered in books read in class and storytelling.

Changes over Time

- Humans go through life stages: baby, toddler, child, teenager, adult and old people.
- Other things change over time too. For example, they can grow, shrink, decay and die.
- The natural world changes over time. Notice the seasons as they occur, draw on what they have experienced in the past.

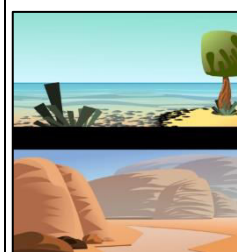

Communities & Traditions

- A community is a group of people who live in a particular place or have something in common.
- E.g. all of the teachers, parents and children at your school make up your school community.
- Your town or village is your local community.
- A tradition is something that people in a group or community do, that has been passed down over time.
- E.g. eating certain foods, wearing certain clothes.



Environments

- Environments are our surroundings.
- Different people, plants and animals like to live in different environments.
- Some examples of natural environments are: garden, forest, beach, desert, rainforest, polar or mountain.
