<div>Adjectives</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>We already know that adjectives usually come <b>after</b> the noun.</li></ul> <p>e.g. a black rabbit = un lapin <u>noir</u></p> <div>There are some exceptions to this rule!</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Size adjectives come <b>before</b> the noun.</li></ul> <p>e.g. a small rabbit = un <u>petit</u> lapin</p>
