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<p><b>What should I know by the end?</b></p> <p><b>Conjugating verbs</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In French, the spelling of a verb changes depending on who is doing the verb.</li> <li>Lots of root verbs in French end in 'er', and all 'er' verbs follow the same rules when changing the spellings. In this topic we will use the verb 'porter' – to wear.</li> <li>When we are using 'porter' with a pronoun, we take off the 'er' and put the correct ending on (look at the vocabulary list).</li> <li>Most of the time we will use 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> person, so we need to know the endings that go with I, You, He and She.</li> <li>It is good to get used to seeing the other ones too!</li> </ul> <p><b>Adjectives</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Most adjectives come after the noun.</li> <li>Size adjectives come before the noun.</li> <li>If the noun is feminine, we usually add an 'e' to the adjective unless it already ends in an 'e'.</li> <li>There are some exceptions to the rule above: e.g. un long pull - a long jumper une longue robe – a long skirt</li> </ul>		<p>Items of clothing</p> <table border="0"> <tr><td>socks</td><td>des chaussettes</td><td>a hat</td><td>un chapeau</td></tr> <tr><td>shoes</td><td>des chaussures</td><td>a tie</td><td>une cravatte</td></tr> <tr><td>trousers</td><td>un pantalon</td><td>a jumper</td><td>un pull</td></tr> <tr><td>shorts</td><td>un short</td><td>a sweatshirt</td><td>un sweat</td></tr> <tr><td>jeans</td><td>un jean</td><td>a t-shirt</td><td>un tee-shirt</td></tr> <tr><td>a dress</td><td>une robe</td><td>trainers</td><td>des baskets</td></tr> <tr><td>a skirt</td><td>une jupe</td><td>a coat</td><td>un manteau</td></tr> </table>		socks	des chaussettes	a hat	un chapeau	shoes	des chaussures	a tie	une cravatte	trousers	un pantalon	a jumper	un pull	shorts	un short	a sweatshirt	un sweat	jeans	un jean	a t-shirt	un tee-shirt	a dress	une robe	trainers	des baskets	a skirt	une jupe	a coat	un manteau	<p><b>What should I be able to do by the end?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Identify different items of clothing</li> <li>Conjugate the verb 'porter'</li> <li>Use adjectives correctly to describe what someone is wearing</li> </ul>	
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
