<u>Adjectives</u> We already know that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adjectives usually come after the noun Size adjectives come before the noun Age adjectives come before the noun <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the noun is feminine, add an 'e' to the adjective UNLESS the adjective already ends in an 'e' AND there are other exceptions. <u>New information:</u> Adjectives that come before the noun are known as BAGS adjectives: Beauty Age Goodness Size e.g. Dans ma maison, il y a un salon calme et un beau jardin. <i>In my house there is a calm living room and a beautiful garden.</i> 'Calm' is not a BAGS adjective, so it comes after the noun (salon), but 'beautiful' is a Beauty adjective so it comes before the noun (jardin).
