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<p>What should I know by the end?</p> <p>Using the pronoun 'on'</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In French, we use the pronoun 'on' when we are talking about 'people' (In English we would say 'you' or 'we' but French have a separate pronoun for these situations). 'On peut' means 'You can'/'We can'/'People can'. It is used with verbs in their <u>infinitive form</u> (the root verb). We can use these to create persuasive sentences. <p>e.g.</p> <p>Viens à Whitby! On peut manger les glaces. Aussi, on peut faire les châteaux des sables.</p> <p>Come to Whitby! You can eat ice creams.
