EXPORTS:

Greece's major export is petrol (similar to Egypt).

It also exports a lot of fresh fish as it has a long coastline, and olive oil as many olive trees grow in Greece.

Greece's main trading partners are Italy and Germany.

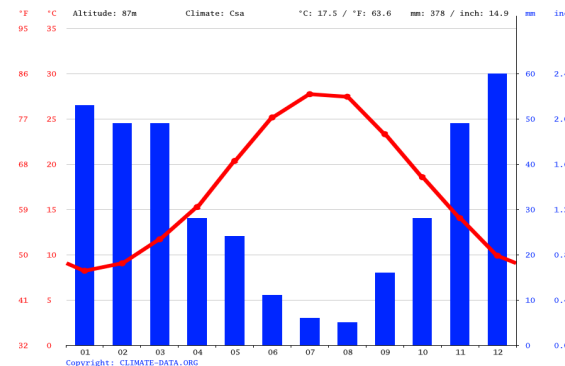
The UK's major export is cars.

CLIMATE:



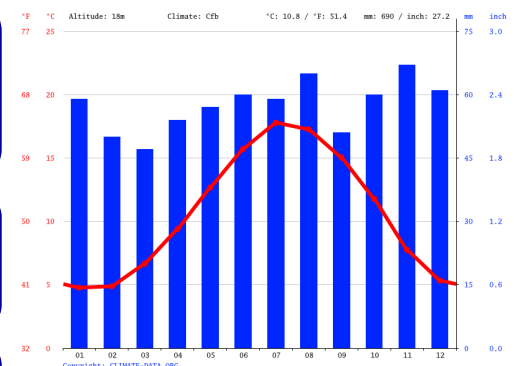
Greece has a Mediterranean climate, and this means that it has hot, dry summers and rainy winters

While the winters are wet, they are not as cold as the UK.

Snow is incredibly rare in Greece.

The average temperature in Greece is higher than the average temperature in the UK.

The average rainfall is far less in Greece than in the UK. The summers are a lot drier.



The UK has a temperate climate, and this means that it has warm, rainy summers and cold, rainy winters.
